



- 5. Taking charge of the RMB Chicago Downtown Chapter is Aleta Williams (Founder of Loquacious Culinary Events), known for her


- exceptional organizational skills and a passion for creating collaborative spaces. Expect dynamic and insightful events under her guidance.





prizes. Rtn. Saravanaraj T. conducted a seminar on "How use Google my business in your business"



- Offer my vocational talents: to provide opportunities for young people, to work for the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community;
- Adhere to honesty in my advertising and in all representations to the public concerning my business or profession;
- Neither seek from nor grant to a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.
